Vented Sleeve

Creates a 4" Finished vented sleeve.


- 1. Cut a strip 9" by the width of your quilt less 1". (i.e. If your quilt is 36" wide, cut a strip 9" x 35".)
- 2. Hem the 9" ends by folding under a $\frac{1}{4}$ " 2 times to the wrong side. Stitch close to the 1st fold. The strip is now 9" x width of quilt less 2".



3. With **wrong sides together, f**old and press the long edges together.



4. Now fold and press the long edges to this pressed line, **wrong** sides together.



- 5. With **wrong** sides together, stitch long edges together with a 1/4" seam allowance. Carefully press seam allowance to one side while not disturbing the pressed lines from step #4.
- 6. Center sleeve 1" from top of quilt with seam allowance next to quilt.
- 7. Using cotton thread, loosely hand stitch sleeve along pressed fold lines.
